SELECTION OF PROPOSALS FOR EVENTS ORGANIZED BY STUDENTS ON THE THEME OF IMMIGRATION

The School of Economics and Political Science encourages the students of the courses of study coordinated by the School (Departments SPGI and dSEA) to submit projects of events on the theme of immigration, which will be the subject of the open public lecture that Professor Christian Dustmann (University College London) will hold in Padua in 2022.

Such events may include, in particular (but not exclusively), panel discussions, round tables with the participation of experts (professors, journalists, politicians), series of films, workshops or book launches with the presence of the author(s).

The School supports at least 4 projects with a contribution of up to 500 euros each. Event proposals must be submitted by 31 March 2022 to economia.scienzepolitiche@unipd.it.

Proposals will be evaluated by mid-April 2022. Events must take place by 15 November 2022.

The selection criteria include:

- (a) collaboration between students from the different Departments belonging to the School;
- (b) relevance of the event for the study and understanding of the phenomenon of immigration;
- (c) originality of the event;
- (d) involvement of the academic community and civil society.
